



Medical Guidelines for Torrence Preschool:

1. **If your child has a fever:** do not send him/her to school for 24 hours after the last time the temperature is elevated without using Tylenol, Ibuprofen, or Motrin.
2. **If your child has diarrhea/vomiting:** do not send them to school for 24 hours after the last time they have diarrhea/vomiting.
3. **Never** send **any** medication with your child.
4. A medical permission form must be signed in order for the nurse/teacher/teacher assistant to administer any medication to your child.
5. **Examples of when to keep your child home:**
 - Temperature of 100 degrees or higher
 - Green nasal discharge
 - Pinkeye
 - Diarrhea
 - Vomiting
 - Coughing constantly
6. When your child is absent from school, please call the office (319-524-1953) to report the absence first thing in the morning each day your child is absent.
7. If your child is taking an antibiotic, please attempt to give this at home.
8. If you discover your child has **head lice**, please let the nurse or teacher know. Guidelines for treatment will be provided.
9. **Keep the school informed** of your current address and telephone number. It is **critical** for the nurse to have a current, workable phone number in case of an emergency. Also, we need at least **three working emergency phone numbers** to use in case we are unable to reach you.
10. A list of immunizations required by law is available. If you do not know which immunizations your child needs, contact your health care provider for that information. Please have all immunizations up-to-date **before** the school year begins.
11. Your child's **health conditions should be kept-up-to-date** on school medical records. Health conditions such as ADHD, asthma, diabetes, heart problems, or seizures, just to name a few, should be on the school records. If medications need to be provided for any health reason, please talk to the school nurse/teacher.
