Immunization requirements for the 2017-2018 school year for incoming 12th grade students include 2 doses of the Meningococcal vaccine if the student was born after September 15, 1999, or 1 dose if received when students are 16 years of age or older. This is **MANDATORY** and required by the state, and needs to be completed before the first day of school next year. More information will be sent out with report cards of incoming 12th graders. 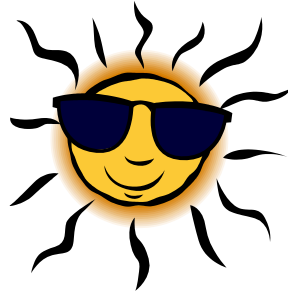

From the Guidance Dept. :

Seniors - as the last day for seniors approaches, seniors will be going to the Guidance Office to request final transcripts be sent to their colleges of choice. If students are 18 years of age, they will be able to complete this request on their own. If they are under the age of 18, a parent/guardian signature is required. We are well aware that plans may change, even during the summer months. If your child needs to have transcripts sent another place during the summer or years to follow, requests can be made in the KHS main office. Once a student has graduated a fee of \$3.00 will be charged for each transcript sent.
