

The Keokuk Community School Foundation awarded \$17,550 in scholarships at Keokuk High School's Class Awards Night on May 13.

The Dr. Bill and Jody Cameron Memorial Scholarship in the amount of \$2500 went to Austin Hartrick, a 2012 KHS graduate who met the criteria of majoring in education and completing at least one year of post-secondary education.

The Dr. Bianca Hendricks Myers Award, a \$500 award given this year to Lakyn Boltz, was established in 2009 by 2000 KHS graduate, Dr. Bianca Myers. This scholarship is awarded annually to a female athlete who excels both academically and athletically. According to the KCSF guidelines for this award, the recipient "must be a well-respected member of the school and of the community and make every effort to be involved in community activities and community service projects."

The Evie Hogan Award was established in 2012 by the Hogan children as a memorial for their mother, who was a secretary in the district for many years. Megan Sigmund was this year's recipient of the \$750 award.

Two Donald Webb Scholarships, \$2500 each, were awarded to Gage Hawkins and Nick Long.

Lakyn Boltz and Maddie Reichman each received a \$2500 Keokuk Community School Foundation Scholarship.

The Webb and Foundation scholarships can be renewed one time each for \$1000.

The Marie Conner Award was given to KHS business student Maddie Reichman in the amount of \$500. Conner was a KHS business teacher.

The Joan Schleier Award was presented to a KHS art student, Kelsey Stamper in the amount of \$400.

The Dr. Karen Wolfmeyer Scholarship was given to Kelsey Stamper in the amount of \$600. This scholarship was started in 2014 in honor of Dr. Karen Wolfmeyer/KHS class of 1957 by her sister Diane Pascoe/KHS class of 1961.

New this year was the Doris Kies Memorial Scholarship in the amount of \$2000 presented to Mercedes Hawkins. This scholarship was donated by the Kies and Wolff families.

Also new this year was the David Mathews Memorial Scholarship, this was given through the Keokuk Area Community Foundation. Erin Otte was the recipient of the \$300 scholarship.
